1 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1.1. EVENT REGULATIONS - Red CentreNATS

The Event organiser agrees drag racing events will be held under the permit which is issued in compliance with the rules and regulations of the Australian National Drag Racing Association Limited (ANDRA) and any further regulations or bulletins which may be issued.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with MSA OH&S, MSA Return to Race protocols, MSA Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the MSA website at www.motorsport.org.au.

ANDRA insurances to cover Drag racing competitors and drag racing specific event officials. Personal Accident Insurance is available automatically to all permanent ANDRA licence holders, including the Single Event Licence, at a Category Two level. For more information please see pages 42 – 44 of the [2019/ 2020 ANDRA Rulebook](#)

This event shall only be abandoned or cancelled in the case of *force majeure* under a decision of the Race Meeting Director.

Any protest or appeal of any result, decision or debate on the interpretation of the rules and regulations of shall be attended by the Meeting Director in conjunction with ANDRA personnel present on the day.

1.2. Alcohol, Drugs and other Substances

Any holder of a 'Competition', 'Crew' or 'Officials' credential (or equivalent credential issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the ANDRA substance abuse policy as published on the ANDRA website.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day.

Accordingly, any holder of a 'Competition', 'Crew' or 'Officials' credential (or equivalent credential issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol in accordance with the ANDRA substance abuse policy.

Event drag racing competition activities will be conducted on Saturday 5th September to Sunday 6th September 2020.

2 EVENT ENTRY

2.1. Entry Fees

Fees from entries opened until midnight 29th May 2020

Regular Entrant	\$50.00
Car Clubs or individuals entering 5 or more vehicles	\$30.00

Fees from 30th May until midnight 21st August 2020

ENTRANT	FEE PER DRIVER
Regular Entrant	\$75.00
Car Clubs or individuals entering 5 or more vehicles	\$60.00
NT Resident Entrant	\$50.00

Pre event entries close at midnight on the 21st of August 2020. Entry after the 21st August will be as a late entry.

Late entries will be accepted up until the 4th of September at the cost of \$100 per driver and vehicle combination, entries will be completed through the online entrant portal with payment only available online.

The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with MSA, NCR 83.

Competitors under 18 years of age must have their entry counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.

2.2. Conditions of entry

The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with the rules and regulations of ANDRA. In addition

- 2.2.1. Competitors must be a full event Entrant and meet the event entry requirements
- 2.2.2. Competitors must pass both event and Drag Racing Scrutineering upon entry to the event
- 2.2.3. Only the vehicle and driver entered the event are eligible to compete. Substitute drivers and/or vehicles are not permitted to take part.

2.3. CODE OF CONDUCT

Refer to Entrant Code of conduct.

3 COMPETITION VEHICLES

3.1. General Requirements

3.1.1. Each vehicle must also comply with the minimum requirements for the category entered as noted in point 4.2:

- Cars slower the 12.00 seconds
- Cars between 12.00 – 10.00 seconds
- Cars quicker than 10.00 – Non ANDRA Licence

NOTE: For competitors holding a permanent ANDRA Licence please contact 08 8271 5355

3.1.2. In addition to the requirement for each driving event the following will apply:

- Firewalls - Complete firewall to isolate driver from engine compartment and fuel tank/cell.
- Fuel tank/cells - Fixed securely with correct brackets. No ratchet straps or temporary fixtures.
- Fuel lines/fillers - All fuel hoses/lines and filler tubes must be designed for automotive use and rated/suited to fuel used. Under no conditions, are any fuel tanks, lines or other units containing fuel permitted in the driver's compartment.

- Inhibitor switch - Automatic Transmission park/neutral start inhibitor switch must be operational.
- Belt Guard - When a blower protrudes from the bonnet, a guard must be fitted over the blower belt.
- Bonnet - Must remain fitted at all times.

4 FUEL

- 4.1.1. It is not permitted to store fuel at BP or ASID. This includes the storage of fuel within or on trucks / transporters that are parked in the designated truck / transporter parking areas at both the venues.
- 4.1.2. Cars participating in drag racing at ASID will be able to take their fuel to the Dragway for use during the competitions. All fuel must be removed from the venue after competition. There is no storage facility at the Dragway. Mind yourself and others when refuelling and competitors/pit crew must be familiar with the location of the nearest fire extinguisher station. No smoking and no children permitted in any refuel area.
- 4.1.3. No naked flames within 10 metres of any point where refuelling or draining of fuel is taking place.
- 4.1.4. Plastic or composite containers are to be approved for the storage of Group Three Dangerous Goods.
- 4.1.5. When refuelling or draining fuel from a vehicle an earth strap must connect the fuel container and fuel tank of the vehicle.
- 4.1.6. Refuelling or draining of fuel from vehicles is not permitted in any enclosed, unventilated area. All ignition sources (electrical fans, battery chargers, welders or any other electrical device) must be removed or switched off before refuelling takes place.
- 4.1.7. Any spill must be cleared immediately and reported to a Track Official.
- 4.1.8. As a minimum, ALL race teams are to have a fire extinguisher meeting the requirements detailed within Driver and Rider Protection, Fire Extinguishers in their paddock area at all times.
- 4.1.9. Premium 98 is available from the bowser at multiple service station in the town of Alice Springs.
- 4.1.10. Specialty race fuels can be purchased in Alice Springs directly from local distributors. It is recommended that you make contact directly with the distributors well in advance to pre order your fuel, as they cannot guarantee you stock availability on the day without your pre order.

5 SCRUTINEERING AND DOCUMENTATION

Registration and Scrutineering is being held at Lasseters Centre of Entertainment. Access will be via the Lasseters Hotel Entry, off Barrett Drive. Follow the signs and the direction from the Red CentreNATS Marshalls.

5.1. Driving event competition licence

To race at the 2020 Red CentreNATS, you require the minimum of the following:

- You must hold or have held an Australian driver's licence. (at a probationary level as minimum)
- An ANDRA Divisional Day Licence is required as a minimum.

- Any pre 2008 vehicle with a known performance of or a performance of 11.00 seconds or quicker on the quarter mile are required to have a technical inspection and logbook issued prior to the event.
- If the vehicle is post 2008 this requirement drops to 10.00 seconds or quicker. For any licencing, logbook or technical queries email info@andra.com.au or call 08 8271 5355

6 DRIVING EVENTS

6.1. General Driving Event Regulations

6.1.1. Passengers in Driving Events

- 6.1.1.1. Passengers require a Divisional Day Licence – see table 4.1
- 6.1.1.2. Passengers are permitted for grudge racing only, at the officials' discretion. All passengers will first be required to complete the ANDRA Acknowledgement of Risk Statement prior to their participation.
- 6.1.1.3. Once the form has been signed and witnessed by a Red CentreNATS official, the passenger will be provided with a passenger wristband. This wristband must remain fitted for the duration of the event, or for the duration of their participation as a passenger. The Passenger Wristband will permit the passenger to participate in any Driving event where passengers are permitted, with the exception of Drag Racing.
- 6.1.1.4. If no Passenger Wristband is fitted, officials will request the passenger to complete an ANDRA Passenger Ride Entrant Form at ASID only prior to their participation (regardless if they have previously signed a form). No signature, no wristband, no participation.
- 6.1.1.5. The Passenger wristband is supplementary to the Chrome Wristband, Officials Pass and Staff pass, therefore you will not gain access into the event venues with the Passenger wristband on its own.
- 6.1.1.6. Maximum of one (1) passenger permitted in the Entrant vehicle at any one time whilst competing.
- 6.1.1.7. Passengers will be required to follow the same safety requirements as the Entrant. Therefore, if they are participating in a competition that requires a fire suit, automotive helmet etc. they too must meet these requirements at notes in point 4.2.

7 DRAG RACING COMPETITION

7.1. The Drag Racing Competition will be conducted in accordance with the ANDRA Rules and Regulations, and the below regulations:

- 7.1.1. The drag racing competition events will be conducted at Alice Springs Inland Dragway
- 7.1.2. Entrants must have the appropriate ANDRA license as listed in 4.1
- 7.1.3. Cars must be suitable in all areas of basic roadworthiness and Scrutineers will examine cars for suitable tyres, no oil leaks, wiring and fuel lines safe and secure, batteries fastened, in addition to complying with the ANDRA Vehicle and Driver Safety Requirements listed in 4.1 and 4.2 and the [current ANDRA Rulebook](#).
- 7.1.4. Passengers will be required to hold a Divisional Day Licence (see table 4.1), sign an ANDRA Passenger Ride Entry form, prior to taking part in the events. Maximum of one (1) passenger permitted. Refer to 5.1.1 for more information around passengers. Solo passes only when passengers are taking part in events. - 7.1.5. Appropriate clothing, footwear and helmets must be worn for all drag racing events. Refer to 4.2 for a complete listing.
